

First/Second Grade Information

Classroom Rules

1. Ask permission to talk or leave your seat
2. Follow all directions
3. Exercise self-control
4. Respect God's word and be kind to others

Homework

Students have a daily homework assignment (except Wednesday) in reading to give them practice at home. First grade students should spend 20 minutes on their homework reading, reading each assignment twice, once to themselves, and once aloud to a parent. Students **must** ask **parents** to sign the assignment when the homework is completed. Second grade students should do the same, spending 30 minutes on their assignment. Once a week (usually Monday) the students have spelling homework. They take their spelling home and copy the words one time and bring them in the following day. Spelling tests begin the second week of school.

Test Envelopes

Each week, students will bring home test envelopes and test papers. Please feel free to view these and go over them with the student. **However**, you must sign and return **every** test paper the next school day. Do not remove test papers and return the folder. The school policy states ALL test papers **MUST** be returned.

Water Bottles

Water bottles are allowed but there are a few stipulations that must be adhered to. No more than 14 oz. bottles will be allowed, as well as, it must be plastic and **have a nozzle on it**.

Supply List

Please check the supply list and make sure that your child does not bring anything to school that is NOT on that list. Anything brought to school that is not on the supply list will be sent home the first time, after that, I will keep it. Also, **NO TRAPPER KEEPERS** are allowed.

Conferences

Please call the school office or send me a note if you would like to set up a conference with me. I will get back to you as soon as I can.

Birthdays

Birthdays are very special occasions for first-second graders. Students may bring a treat to share with the class on their birthday. Please keep the treat simple and inexpensive. PLEASE do not arrange private parties through the school (see Student Handbook). This can be very embarrassing to students not included.
